



## Essential Cat Supplies: First-Time Owner's Checklist

### Transportation

- Sturdy Cat Carrier (Hard-shell recommended for safety)
- Comfortable Bedding/Blanket for Carrier

### Feeding

- Separate Food Bowl (Ceramic or Stainless Steel)
- Separate Water Bowl (Ceramic or Stainless Steel)
- Raised Feeding Bowls (For older cats or those with joint issues)
- Water Fountain (Optional, encourages hydration)
- Cat Food (Wet and/or Dry, consult your vet)

### Sleeping

- Cat Bed (With raised sides for security)
- Soft Fleece Blanket
- Cat Tree with Sleeping Platforms (Optional, provides vertical space)
- Radiator Hammock (Optional, for warmth)

### Toileting

- 2 Litter Trays (One per cat plus one extra)
- Cat Litter (Same type cat is used to, initially)
- Litter Scoop
- Litter Tray Liners or Mat (Optional, for easier cleaning)

### Play & Enrichment

- Fishing Rod Toy (For interactive play)
- Catnip or Silvervine Toys (For stimulation)
- Scratching Post (Tall and sturdy, protects furniture)
- Cat Tree (With scratching surfaces, encourages exercise)

### Grooming

- Brush or Comb (Appropriate for your cat's coat type)
- Nail Clippers (Use with caution, ask your vet for a demo)
- Cat Toothbrush and Toothpaste (For dental health)

### Health & Safety

- Microchip (Essential for identification, ensure contact details are updated)
- Flea and Worm Treatments (Consult your vet for recommendations)
- Pet First Aid Kit (For minor emergencies)
- Pet Insurance (Highly recommended, helps with unexpected costs)
